



Updated guidelines for Classement and Competitions following AS meeting February



Classement days, Race to Tombeboeuf etc..

Guidelines: From the month of March onwards, every 2nd and 4th week of the month players will have the opportunity of competing in either one or both of the classement competitions. The best of those scores will be entered into the classement. **A reminder in order to compete** in the main club competitions players will be required to have competed in a minimum of 2 classements. For both men and women those with a handicap in excess of 36 the classement can be 9 holes, those players with a handicap of 36 and under, the classement must be 18 holes.

Requirement : a maximum of one classement per week during the 2nd or 4th week of the month.

Check in at the club on arrival and purchase a specific classement card from reception, on completion of your round, regardless of your performance, make sure your card is signed correctly and return it to reception.

Entry fees: Members of the Association 3 euros for 9 holes and 5 euros for 18 holes. Non association members 5 euros for 9 holes and 10 euros for 18 holes. All monies raised go towards prizes and the running of the AS, managing handicaps etc.

ALL CARDS MUST BE RETURNED, PLAYERS WHO DO NOT RETURN CARDS RISK NOT BEING ABLE TO COMPETE IN FUTURE CLASSEMENTS.

Allowances will be made as a result of any special circumstances relating to COVID and agreed with the club or the association.

COMPETITIONS : FFG LICENCE HOLDERS ONLY

Management : Nico the pro helped by all of the AS committee members.

Requirements: MINIMUM 2 classements competitions in order to enter the club competitions (within the 6 months prior to the day of the club competition.)

Costs: Association members 5 euros for a classement event, 10 euros for non AS members or visitors. (fees go towards prizes and mgmt of the AS)
